DESCRIPTION OF COURSES TAUGHT

Jazz Styles and Analysis

This is a graduate level course tracing the development of jazz styles from ragtime to jazz/rock fusion, including Dixieland, Swing, Bebop, Cool Jazz, Hard Bop, Modal, and the Avant-garde. Emphasis is placed on the innovations of Louis Armstrong, Charlie Parker, John Coltrane, and Miles Davis. Students are required to demonstrate knowledge of each stylistic period by presenting oral and written reports focusing on a particular artist.

Jazz Combo

This is a graduate/undergraduate level course providing students an opportunity to perform in a variety of small group settings. Students shall develop skills enabling them to master numerous musical situations. Emphasis is placed on tune memorization from the “Standards” repertoire, proficiency on the student’s individual instrument, and the ability to improvise in a variety of idioms. Students are encouraged to rehearse and perform original compositions and arrangements.

Jazz Big Band

This class is a graduate/undergraduate level course providing students an opportunity to perform in a big band ensemble. All styles of big band jazz are explored, from Swing through Funk Rock and the Avant-garde, including such notable writers as Sammy Nestico, Bob Mintzer, Matt Harris, and Maria Schneider. Students shall develop skills in all areas of ensemble execution including dynamics, balances, intonation, attacks and releases, sight-reading, improvisation, and interaction with the rhythm section. Students are also encouraged to rehearse and perform original compositions and arrangements.

Individual Applied Acoustic Bass

A comprehensive overview of acoustic bass styles from Jimmy Blanton through John Patitucci, including Ray Brown, Paul Chambers, Scott LaFaro, and Ron Carter is offered. The student is required to demonstrate technical proficiency on the instrument, including scales and arpeggios, as a prerequisite for jazz studies. Much emphasis is placed on improvisation, including chord-scale theory, major modes, melodic minor modes, harmonic minor modes, pentatonic/diminished scales and transcription analysis. Tune memorization, ear training, and keyboard skills are also addressed.

Individual Applied Electric Bass

A comprehensive overview of electric bass styles from Monk Montgomery to Victor Wooten, including Larry Graham, Bootsy Collins, Jaco Pastorius, Marcus Miller, and Stanley Clarke is offered. The student is required to demonstrate technical proficiency on the instrument, including scales and arpeggios, as a prerequisite for jazz studies. Much emphasis is placed on improvisation, including chord-scale theory, major modes, melodic minor modes, harmonic minor modes, pentatonic/diminished scales, and transcription analysis. Tune memorization, ear training, and keyboard skills are also addressed.

Enjoyment of Music

This class is a comprehensive overview of the history of Western Music from the middle Ages through the current century. Emphasis is placed on the “Classical” repertoire in order to give students knowledge and appreciation for this idiom. Composers studied include Bach, Haydn, Mozart, Beethoven, Brahms, Schubert, Tchaikovsky, Debussy, and Ravel. Also included are Wagner, Copeland, Stravinsky, Schoenberg, Berg, Varese, and Cage.

Evolution of Jazz

This is a humanities course designed to meet the general education requirements as outlined in the school's academic charter. This course is designed to give non-music majors an appreciation and understanding of the evolution of jazz styles. Through the use of video and audio footage, students can learn to enjoy the various aspects of the jazz language.

Jazz Improvisation

This class is a comprehensive overview of the mechanics involved in jazz improvisation. The undergraduate course focuses on developing the ability to spontaneously create viable musical contributions, while simultaneously grasping the theoretical implications of the musical statements. In order to facilitate this goal, examples and assignments are utilized from the Great American Songbook, as well as more modern jazz repertoire.
